GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONCRETE

The Temafloor 5000M is screed produced on site by adding a suitable sand filler to Temafloor 500M epoxy resin.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The recommended film thickness is between 1 to 1.7 mm. Please see the product data sheet for full preparation instructions. The concrete flooring should have sufficient structural integrity to withstand the required preparation work, to support the coating, and to resist the stresses it will be exposed to.
